Great Lakes Community Center Policies

Park and Walking Trail Hours: Sunrise to Sunset.

- 1. The Community Center and its grounds are for the exclusive use of Midwest Family Housing residents, authorized occupants, and their guests. All guests must be accompanied by their resident sponsor.
- 2. In the Great Lakes Community Center, anyone 16 and under must be accompanied by a parents at all times. Anyone violating this policy will be asked to leave the Community Center, and may be barred from the facility upon subsequent infractions.
- 3. Midwest Family Housing reserves the right to bar any Resident, or their Occupants, from the Community Center, for poor behavior, causing property damage, or disturbing the enjoyment of the Center for other Visitors.
- 4. Please report any malfunctioning equipment, or fixtures in need of repair, to the Management Office located in the Community Center, in Suite 100.
- 5. Additional information is also available in your Community Handbook.

Within the limits of the Great Lakes Community Center, and the parks and trails, it is prohibited for any person to:

- Willfully or intentionally destroy, damage, or injure any Midwest Family Housing facility and property;
- Climb onto any wall, fence, building, monument, excluding play areas designated for climbing:
- Kindle, build, maintain, or use any fire, other than in designated grills;
- Distribute, post or place any commercial handbill or circular, notice or other advertising matter;
- Wash, polish or repair cars or other vehicles;
- Enter or remain on premises during the night hours that the community center and parks are closed;
- Sell or offer for sale any services, merchandise, article or thing, whatsoever;
- Amplify music or use battery operated loudspeakers (bull horns);
- Ride upon roller skates, skateboards, or bicycles
- Pet(s) must be in Person's control at all times on a leash, cord, chain or other similar means of physical restraint of not more than eight (8) feet in length;
- Person(s) must clean up after pet by using and discarding disposable bags;
- Pet(s) must display a valid license tag attached to their collar.
- The possession or consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited in the Community Center.
